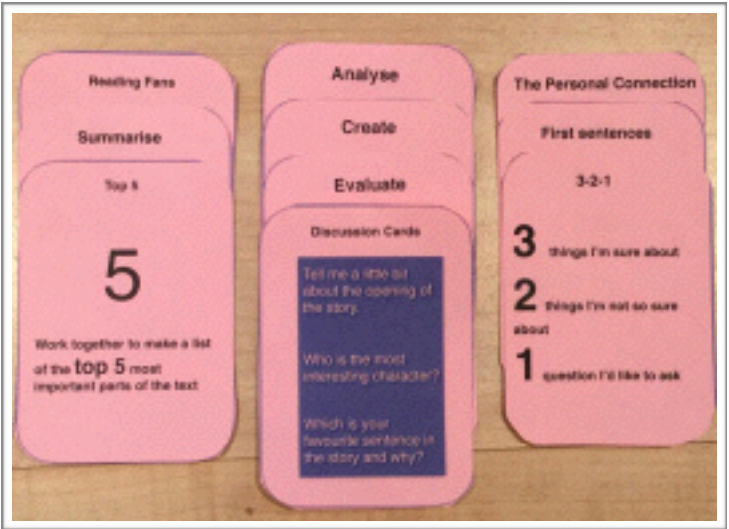


Challenging the More Able in Reading
